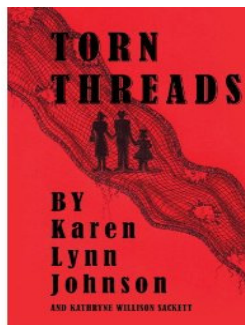
Health and Cheer
